

Ft. Moultrie Living History Uniform Requirements

1. Coat – Single breasted Frock Coats REQUIRED – Preferred grays or browns. Frocks MUST BE CLEAN and in good repair. Appropriate fabrics: Jeans, Satinette, Cassimere. Buttonholes MUST be Handsewn. Suggested maker's: Ben Tart, Chris Daley, Nick Sekela, Pat Brown
2. Headgear – Caps REQUIRED – Preferred gray or brown – NO extraneous brass/hat emblems/etc. Leather or painted cloth brims. Appropriate fabrics: Jeans, Satinette, Cassimere. Suggested maker's: Greg Starbuck, Brad Malone, Dirty Billy.
3. Trouser's – Documented Confederate Pattern or Civilian – ABSOLUTELY NO Federal Sky Blues – Trouser's MUST BE CLEAN and in good repair. Appropriate fabrics: Jeans, Satinette, Cassimere. Buttonholes MUST be Handsewn.
4. Accouterments –Black or black iron dyed ONLY – NO RUSSET!
 - a. Belts: Roller Buckle, Frame buckle, Clipped Corner Plate, Forked Tongue, South Carolina Plate, NO US PLATES Suggested vendors: LD Haning, Skillet Licker, Don Smith – TMD, S&S, etc.
 - b. Cartridge Box: Documented pattern with box sling – NO Plates – Tins and sling REQUIRED. Suggested vendors: LD Haning, Skillet Licker, Don Smith – TMD, Butch Myers, etc.
 - c. Scabbard – Documented pattern – Bayonet and Scabbard ARE REQUIRED; Scabbard must have tip or finial. Suggested vendors: LD Haning, Skillet Licker, Don Smith – TMD, Brad Malone, Butch Myers, etc.
 - d. Cap Pouch – Documented Pattern. Suggested vendors: LD Haning, Skillet Licker, Don Smith – TMD, Brad Malone, etc.
5. Haversack – Documented Confederate pattern – Moses Alexander, Eutaw Rifles, Yancy Dean HL (no tarring preferred, but MUST be clean!)
6. Weapon – 3 Bands weapons only - '53 Enfield, '61/'63 Springfield, '42 Springfield, etc.– no flintlock/wheelock/matchlock (NPS Rules)
7. Canteens: Tin drum or Gardner Pattern preferred; leather or cloth strap. No US Canteens.
8. Brogans: Black ONLY, in good repair – English Import, Jefferson Pattern, etc.

9. White Gloves – Will be provided to all registrants.

10. Garrison gear: Bed rolls, bed sacks, blankets, quilts (yes, quality quilts!), coverlets, packs, tent flies, etc. are permitted at Fort Moultrie but will not be worn or carried in the Funeral Procession. Due to the limited green space within the walls of Fort Moultrie, it is not possible to erect tentage. Ft. Moultrie NP will be under National Park Service guard during the Funeral procession and burial.
